Thursdays 5.30-6:15pm, Starts Sept 19th

Step into the world of folk music. Ensemble based course centred on Celtic Music, with explorations of other Folk Music cultures. Available to Musicians on Violin (Fiddle), Viola, Cello, Flute, Harp, Guitar, Mandolin, Percussion, or Vocalists.

#### Senior Jazz Combo

Sundays 4:30-5:25pm, Starts Sept 22nd

An exploration of Jazz music, including Swing, Latin, Blues and more! Available to confident youth musicians on brass, woodwinds, drums, keyboard, guitar & bass. Musicians will learn to solo and accompany in a jazz band setting and how to improvise.

### Senior Chamber Music (NE



Sundays, biweekly, Starting Sept 29th (timing dependent on placement)

The exact makeup of the ensembles will depend on enrollment. Available to all confident youth musicians on classical instruments looking to challenge themselves; including piano, harp, and classical guitar.

Ensembles are eligible for a 50% discount if enrolled in an Orchestra!

### **The Orchestras**

### The Junior Kawartha Youth Orchestra (JYKO)

Tuesdays 6:15-7:30pm, starts Sept 17th

The first stop on your orchestra journey. Learn to play in an ensemble with strings, winds, and brass. Musicians are expected to be able to properly hold and confidently produce sound on their instruments. Approximate RCM Grade 1-2.

### \$925/year - \$325/term

#### The Intermediate Kawartha Youth Orchestra (IYKO)

Thursdays 6:15-7:30pm, starts Sept 19th

Taking Orchestral music to the next level. Play classical favorites and popular arrangements with a full orchestra of peers. Musicians are expected to be able to read music and learn parts semi-independently (support provided in sectionals). Approximate RCM Grades 3-5.

### The Senior Kawartha Youth Orchestra (SYKO)

Sundays 2:30-4:15pm, starts Sept 22nd

The KYO's premier orchestra, playing standard orchestral repertoire.
Intended for confident youth musicians committed to their instruments.
Approximate RCM Grades 6 plus.

## **Supplementary Courses**

\$500/term

### **Digital Music Production**

Term 1, Sept 19th - Nov 21st Thursdays 7:30-8:15pm

Learn to record, produce and mix your own music! Participants will learn to use a Digital Audio Workstation (DAW) and essential microphone techniques. Learn to work in whatever genre is most exciting to you. Participants must provide their own laptop or tablet and have a baseline

understanding of music.

### **Theory**

Term 2, Jan 16th- March 23rd Thursdays 7:30-8:15pm

Go beyond reading music to understand harmony, counterpoint, form, and analysis. Will prepare participants for a university music entry exam or the equivalent of RCM Harmony 1. Will include additional information on styles beyond classical music (folk, pop, and jazz).

### Composition

Term 3, April 3rd – June 5th Thursdays 7:30-8:15pm

Write your own music! Learn to compose for your instrument and beyond. Focusing on solo and chamber composition. Students are expected to have a baseline of music theory understanding and be confident on an instrument of their choosing. Laptops are recommended but not required.

Courses are eligible for a 50% discount if enrolled in an Orchestra!
